More recently, it is proposed by both EFSA (the European Food Safety Authority) and JECFA (the Joint FAO/WHO Expert Committee on Food Additives) that MOE approach could be applied for risk assessment of genotoxic and carcinogenic presents. Then, JECFA carried about risk assessment of acrylamide, fran, and others using MOE approach in the 72th JECFA in 2010.

ILSI Japan Risk Assessment Taskforce recognized the importance of assessment using MOE approach by JECFA, and was asked to write about the assessment results in the 72th JECFA to Dr. Hirose, the director of division of risk assessment, biological safety research center, NIHS, who had participated in the conference.
